The Art of Teaching Jazz - Latin is a course for music educators that includes a focus on best practices for rehearsal tactics and strategies, rehearsal planning, repertoire, and performance specific to Latin style music. The art of teaching Latin jazz is an integral part of developing skills, knowledge, and experiences needed to become and function as a jazz conductor-teacher.

In this course, participants will be doing hands-on learning, providing synopsis reflections on each session, and developing action plans for classroom implementation. The final project will involve a personal reflection of the process. The AEA Learning Online Moodle platform will be used for discussion and completion of required activities.

These best conductor-teacher practices will support and connect to the Iowa Fine Arts standards through the process of creating action plans for classroom implementation.

Important note: This is a blended course with **required attendance** at the Summer Jazz Symposium. This event is a shared initiative among the Iowa Bandmasters and the Jazz Educators of Iowa. It is envisioned as a Symposium for hands-on presentations, discussions, and blended learning activities focused on the Art of Teaching Jazz.-Latin
